No guidance yet for COVID-19 measures in schools for term 4. Impacts all events next term including twilight etc and will communicate as soon as known.

Staggered start and end times will change in Term 4. Parents are still not to enter school grounds. All stages will start at 8:50am but will have separate waiting areas in the playground. Staggered end times will continue... ie kindy from car park, year 1 at Centennial gates at 2:45, year 2 at small Centennial gate at 2:50?, all Stage 2 at 3pm.

Thanks everyone for patience and submitted questions regarding the music program for 2021. Bronwyn and Alex have been working hard to address questions but more new questions than answers. Waiting for clarification from the department before messages will be shared, hopefully early next term. Meanwhile, the school is discussing options with music directors also.

Invoices went out last week and school has received additional \$16,000 in P&C contributions since last week. Current total is \$128,900 that the school has in P&C contributions collected.

Today we had four or five Project User Groups ("PUG"s) for the new school build, for various target areas of school design. A very valuable day and more PUGs will happen next term. It was wonderful to have a variety of staff participating today with a wide range of skills.

Question: Since we cannot drop off kids for before-school-care at Centennial gate, we have to guide through the carpark. Unfortunately, some parents are driving into the carpark and pedestrians have had to leap out of the way.

Alex: OOSH say it's a staffing issue, would need one extra staff to take drop-off at Centennial Ave. Alex has spoken to OOSH to fix this concern and will push the issue further.

Question: Can we do anything about the increasing dangerous and illegal parking by parents in Oliver Road?

Alex: We will get the Rangers onto the problem, Alex will go herself also, and more notes will be published in the newsletter.

Question: Is crazy hair and sock day also full mufti

Alex: Given the kids have had to miss out on excursions and camps this term - the least we can do is give them a mufti day. The school will confirm to both teachers and parents on Wednesday.

# **President's Report**

Welcome and thank you to everyone for attending this evening - particularly those who are joining us for the first time. This is our second last "normal' P&C meeting of the year before the AGM (Annual General Meeting) is held in November

Each year at the AGM in late November, all Officer and other positions will become vacant and then be filled by nomination and, where necessary, by ballot of members.

There are a couple of rules in terms of holding a position:

- All nominees need to be a paid member of the Association and membership is by gold coin donation. If you are not a paid up member but wish to put your name forward for a position, and or vote you can put your gold coin in an envelope and put in the black P&C box on the wall at the main campus office (or hand in at the front desk at bush campus) or have your child do it. Or you can do an online direct deposit if that is easier. If you are unsure if you are paid up please contact Joe by emailing the P&C secretary. Membership takes effect after the meeting at which the membership is deemed paid. So you would need to be paid up by next (October) meeting to be in time for November AGM.
- No person can serve more than three consecutive years in the same Executive position unless there is no other nominee and the additional term is approved by the Association.
- Positions are: President, vice president x 2, secretary, treasurer, canteen and uniform shop convenor and treasurer, class parent coordinator, events convenor, school grounds convenor,

We will sadly be losing our amazing Canteen treasurer next year - Shing has done an amazing job, is always diligent and has particularly risen to the challenge of all the red tape this year with the ATO and Covid packages.

If you would like to put your hand up for any position including my own - it would be great if you could reach out in the next few weeks to myself or Joe and make yourself known. There is an extensive document on the school website P&C page with job descriptions which I will have included in the minutes - but if you have any questions - please let me know. These are great opportunities for parents who would otherwise not be able to give their time during the working week to volunteer at the school.

I would like to give thanks to our Class Parent Coordinator and Class parents across the K-6 years for their assistance in communicating with parents particularly in the last month. Your help in gaining momentum for the "Tell them from Me" survey was particularly helpful with 1000 surveys completed in a little over 2 weeks, although I am not sure how the school feels about the 9 pizza parties though!

#### **COMMUNITY DIRECTORY**

There was a proposal put forward in the last meeting to put together a community directory of parent owned businesses at the school with a motion proposed to be put forward at tonight's meeting. The executives have discussed this suggestion further and we agree that it does not fall under the principal aims of the P&C, being to "promote the interests of the school" and "assist in providing facilities and equipment for the school". There were also concerns raised with the extent of guidelines that would be required around what businesses could or could not take part and the policing of such and also a potential implied recommendation in providing this avenue for advertisements. At this stage the P&C Exec would recommend we do not move forward with the proposal however we would welcome a discussion if anyone feels strongly about this matter and/or would like to make comment.

#### **SCHOOL BUILD**

A project update was included in last week's newsletter. It confirmed that Richard Crookes Construction, who have a proven track record in school buildings, has been appointed as the contractor for building R and to complete the design for the primary school. At this time, it is expected building R will start construction at the end of this year, and the primary school to commence at the beginning of 2021 however this is dependent on approval of the SSDA.

As the project moves into the design and construction phase, the old PRG has effectively been disbanded and a new one is being formed with new Terms of Reference. One of these is that each of the schools can only have one P&C rep within the group. At this time, I will be taking on the role as representing the primary school P&C. As required for the design, our convenors will also be consulted with respect to the canteen and uniform shop.

I would like to take this opportunity on behalf of the P&C to give Joe Grundy recognition and thanks for all the time and effort he has put into the project and attendance at, I believe 33 of the 34 PRG meetings held to date since October 2017. The project would not be where it is today without Joe's considerable input.

The big question on everyone's mind at this stage is "how will the staging work?" I can report that the staging plan is being finalised with Infrastructure, RCC and detailed consultation with the school execs and we hope that this information will be made public to our school community in October.

Just a reminder that if anyone has any questions about the project at any time, they are welcome and encouraged to email Schools infrastructure whose email address is at the bottom of every project update.
