Chatswood Public School P&C Insurance premium for 2015-16 was \$2,774. Inclusions were: Membership and Public Liability 50 Million; Cash and property cover; Association liability cover; Personal accidental death benefit; Motor vehicle excess; Fidelity Insurance; Director and Officer Insurance.

Assuming the same rates, with an increase in property (Canteen and Uniform shop stock and equipment figures confirmed by sub-committees) by 13K, the premium would come to under \$3,000.

Motion: to approve approximately \$3,500 for insurance premium for 2016-17 allowing for changes in plan structure and rates. Moved by Joe Grundy, Seconded by Brett Backhouse, motion passed.

Welcome

On behalf of the P&C Executive I'd like to welcome you all to our fourth meeting of the year.

Apart from the usual activities, we have a number of items to discuss tonight, not least of which is an update by Tim on the Learning Support Program and the DoET's master plan for the school. I'll discuss the latter in more detail in my report.

President's Report

As always there has been a lot of activity in the school in the past month.

Angela Todd, Andrea Austin, Joe Grundy and I attended a meeting of the P&C Federation on Thursday 16 June at Forest High. A number of northern Sydney schools were represented. A number of different and interesting topics were discussed in regard to the requirements and obligations of P&C associations, and some examples of the various approaches P&Cs take in relation to these issues and how they interact with the school. The P&C at Chatswood Public School appears to be in a good position both from a financial and governance perspective, although there were several items we've subsequently sort to tidy. Many thanks to Ange and Andrea for their pro-active approach in resolving any discrepancies. Some slight revisions to the P&C's Standard Operating Procedures and By-Laws have been posted to the website, as well a Grievance Policy.

Apart from the previously mentioned re-development of the Chatswood High School sports ground going ahead (between November and April), unfortunately other areas of the school's Master Plan have fallen silent. Neither Chatswood Public School or Chatswood High School was mentioned in last week's NSW Budget update, which is rather disconcerting. Our student numbers continue to grow significantly each year and the P&C believes government funding should be provided for capital works to provide additional classrooms. The P&C Executive have resolved to follow up with our local member Gladys Berijiklian and provide an update following our July 2015 meeting.

I would like to thank the many volunteers for the contribution to the ongoing activities of the Canteen and Uniform Shop as well as those who have helped with recent school events. Without your involvement our children would not benefit from such a caring school community which allows them to thrive.

The P&C will be holding a Working Bee on Sunday 24 July (1-4pm), the first weekend back after the school holidays.

With the new Environmental Education focusing on activities such as the growing of produce and the natural environment at the Bush Campus, Tim has indicated a number of other areas within the broader school he would like us to focus our efforts on.
