

Winter Uniforms

- Winter Uniform is required for both Term 2 and Term 3. It is a good time now to check that your children's winter uniform still fits.
- There is a 2-week cross over period to transition between Summer and Winter Uniforms.

- All items are to be purchased in person at the Uniform Shop located at Bush Campus (access through Freeman Road) during our regular opening hours of 8am 10.30am, every Mondays to Thursdays, during Term Time.
- As a reminder, online orders will cease as the Online Shop will also be turned off for the time being until after the rollout of the new uniform lines and have better inventory levels.

Fitting Appointments

- New Winter Uniform Fitting appointments will be available from Monday, 27 March 2023 (Week 10) however this is only going to be for fittings mainly as we are still awaiting some items that will be arriving in the coming weeks. Priority for purchasing of the new uniforms is given to Kindergarten, Year 5 OC and New Students.
- Appointments must be made to ensure correct sizes are given especially with the rollout of the new uniforms. Booking slots are 15-20 minutes and single bookings per student are required.

- In order to ensure we have enough inventory for all without uniforms, we will be limiting purchases to a maximum of 2 sets of official winter uniform and 1 set of sports uniform. Further inventory stock will be replenished in the coming months.

- We will re-open Monday, 24th April from 8am 3pm.
- Students return to school on Wednesday, 26th April in either Summer or Winter Uniforms as there


